Plant Facts

- There are 420 robots at Ohio Assembly Plant.
- The assembly line at Ohio Assembly Plant spans approximately 19 conveyor miles.
- The Ohio Assembly Plant received Ford's Community Outreach Environmental Leadership Award for a unique contest for grade school students, challenging them to design labels for recycling containers in the plant.

Recent News

- In 2014, Ford invested \$168 million to shift production of all-new 2016 Ford F-650 and F-750 medium-duty trucks from Mexico to Ohio Assembly Plant.
- Part of the 2014 investment included the installation of 38 painting robots, the refurbishment of one of the enamel spray booths and oven and the consolidation of the paint recirculating systems to minimize paint waste.
- Full van and club wagons production was shut down in June of 2014 to make room for the medium duty trucks.
- Ohio Assembly Plant still produces E-Series Cutaways and Stripped Chassis


